

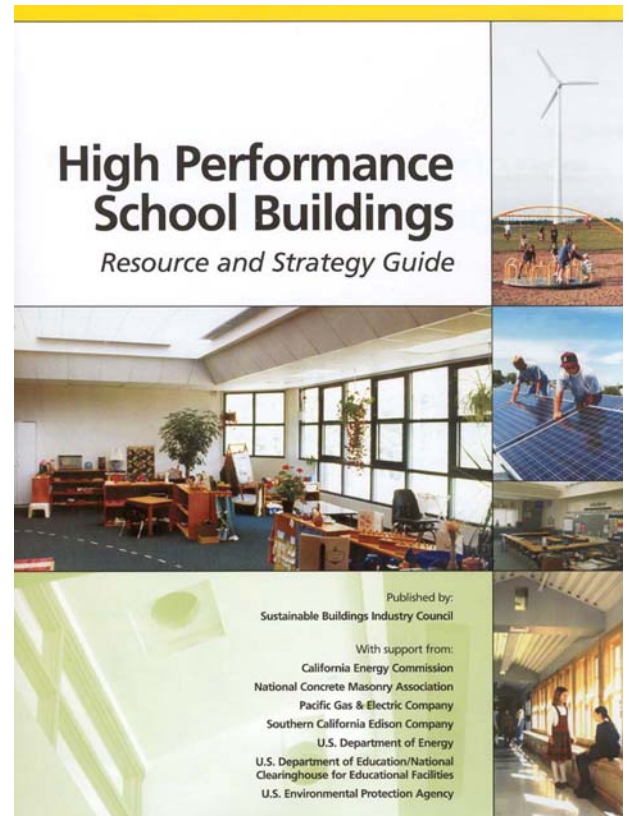


High Performance Schools

Project Data: Resource and Strategy Guide

SWA manages this project for the Sustainable Buildings Industry Council, under contract with the US Department of Energy. High-Performance Schools workshops have been developed and delivered to encourage the design and construction of energy efficient and green schools. Since 1999, SBIC has conducted more than a dozen major workshops and related presentations to architects, engineers, and school decision-makers about the benefits of high-performance school buildings and the design strategies to achieve them. SBIC's Schools Team developed the High Performance School Buildings Resource and Strategy Guide as the primary teaching tool for the workshops. The Guide has also proved to be a popular and valuable stand-alone publication (details at www.sbicouncil.org).

To help SBIC reach a wider audience with its road-tested message about high-performance school buildings, SWA and the SBIC project team developed a web-based tutorial to prepare concerned citizens to serve as local advocates or "circuit riders" and deliver authoritative, persuasive, and consistent presentations about the benefits of high-performance schools in their own communities.
